DAY-BY-DAY

Itinerary

DAY 1

Arusha to Tarangire

Early departure to reach Tarangire for morning golden light. Full day photographing elephant herds against baobab backdrops. Focus on portraits, action shots, and landscape compositions. Stay until sunset for dramatic silhouettes. Overnight at midrange lodge.

DAY 2

Tarangire to Serengeti

Sunrise photography session in Tarangire. After breakfast, drive to the Serengeti. Afternoon game drive focusing on big cats and the vast plains. Golden hour shooting at kopjes. Overnight at midrange tented camp.

DAY 3

Serengeti Photography Day 1

Pre-dawn departure for sunrise on the plains. Full day dedicated to big cat photography — lions, leopards, and cheetahs. Your guide positions for optimal backgrounds and lighting. Extended afternoon session until last light. Overnight at midrange tented camp.

DAY 4

Serengeti Photography Day 2

Another full day in the Serengeti. Focus on different subjects — elephants, giraffes, hippos, and birdlife. Visit river areas for reflection shots and dramatic crossings. Sunset silhouette session. Overnight at midrange tented camp.

DAY 5

Serengeti Photography Day 3

Final full day in the Serengeti. Morning focus on predator-prey interactions. Afternoon landscape and wildlife combinations. Golden hour session for portfolio shots. Review and share images at camp. Overnight at midrange tented camp.

DAY 6

Ngorongoro Crater & Departure

Drive to Ngorongoro and descend into the crater for morning photography. Capture the Big Five in the dramatic crater setting. Flamingo shots at the soda lake. After lunch, ascend and drive to Arusha. Arrive by evening.
